GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS SCOPE OF THE PAPER SUBMISSION
RULES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS

The written presentation should preferably be typed (double space) on bond paper, (size 11”*8”), leaving 3 cms margin and should be between 2500 to 3000 words for Category A and B. For Category C the word limit is 4500 to 5000 words. Charts, diagrams, etc. may be included to support any research work or data collection.

The first page of the written submission should have the format as given below:

Each individual is required to submit 2 copies of their written paper, ONLY IN ENGLISH, with their Registration Number clearly mentioned on the top.

RULES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS

1. Each participant will have to ensure that their paper submission does not exceed the word limit assigned to the respective category.
2. The paper submission has to be ONLY IN ENGLISH, original and the idea should not have been published or used by anyone before.
3. No individual would be allowed to make more than one submission. In the event more than one submission is made, by the same individual, all such copies will be treated as null and void and the participation fee will be forfeited.
4. These submissions will be evaluated by a panel of judges on the following parameters for a total score of 100. The break-up is as under:
 - Originality & Creative Thinking – 30 marks
 - Analytical Treatment & Depth of Study (Including accuracy) – 30 marks
 - Writing style & Presentation – 20 marks
 - Idea Implications – 20 marks
5. The Top 100 entries will be required to go through a Telephonic Interview with the Jury Member. No change from the original should be permitted at any stage.
6. The LCD Projector and laptop will be provided at the Grand Finale at New Delhi.
7. **No participant will be allowed to submit fresh/written report on the day of National Finals.**
8. The participant should bring main findings and points in their presentation before the Judges.
9. The decision of the Panel of Judges will be final and binding on the participating teams.
10. Decision of PowerCon Knowledge Services Pvt. Ltd will be final in all respects in matters relating to the Competition.
